2. Map Work

In this worksheet, you are going to make your own map of North America. There is a blank outline map on the next page. Find the places listed below in your atlas. Then, draw and label them into the blank map. Some of these places you can probably find easily, just by looking at the atlas. But if you have trouble finding any of them, use your index.

If you are feeling artistic, you can use different colors for rivers, cities, mountain ranges, etc. You can also make yourself a map key with the symbols for mountains, rivers, plateaus, and the like. If you do not know what a map key is, look at the first page in your atlas. There is a map key for the atlas there.

- A. Countries: Canada, United States of America, Mexico, Greenland, Guatemala, Belize, El Salvador, Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Panama, Cuba, Jamaica, Haiti, Dominican Republic

- B. Cities: Washington D.C., New York, Chicago, Los Angeles, Calgary, Toronto, Mexico City, Havana

- C. Freshwater: Mississippi River, Missouri River, Colorado River, Lake Superior

Salt water: Hudson Bay, Gulf of Mexico, Caribbean Sea, Davis Strait, Atlantic Ocean, Arctic Ocean

- D. Mountain Ranges: Rocky Mountains, Appalachian Mountains, Sierra Nevada Mountains, Sierra Madre del Sur

Other: Victoria Island, Baffin Island, Mt. McKinley, Yucatan Peninsula
